Inventions are happening at a rapid pace to handle big data for almost an infinite number of applications. Development of various new tools, be it software or hardware, is impacting the technologies in a big way. Development of Chip on full wafer would increase the chip capacity presently handling 20 billion transistors to 1.2 trillion transistors resulting in more speed, power, memory and so on. The availability of quantum computers may no longer be a mere dream. Conversion of unstructured big data into structured data for training software, algorithm for statistical models and predictive capabilities will go a long way in determining the market leadership in these areas. There is a need for paradigm shift in how we look at these capabilities for the purpose of awarding patents and other IPR.

With millions of patent applications being filed every year all over the world, we need to have standards in documentation for filing patent applications to reduce the time of examination and the cost involved.
