Valuation is considered as one of the most critical areas in finance. Valuation of intellectual property rights is part of the good management of intellectual property within an organization. Valuation of Intellectual Property Rights helps us to get the Economic Value of Intellectual Property. Which helps to get idea on existing assets and help to take decisions on commercialization and Licensing using the intellectual property rights. An intellectual property licensing agreement occurs between an IP rights applicant (licensor) and someone who is authorized to use the rights (licensee) in exchange for monetary value in the form of a fee or a royalty, or both.
